





# Information Increases Support

### 2. Technology and Capital Projects Levy

 supports technology and facility needs for students and staff not funded by the State.


Both must be renewed every 4 years

  - 16% of operating budget
  - 87% of technology
  - 94% of capital projects
- Environment of funding uncertainty
- LWSD has a history of responsible, forwardlooking budgeting and commitment to taxpayers
- Levy funds protect the programs and services LWSD parents expect

### **EP&O Recommendation**

Collection Year	Levy Amount (\$ in Millions)	Rate/\$1,000
2027	<del>\$125.6</del> \$124.5	<del>\$1.00</del> \$0.99
2028	<del>\$132.9</del> \$131.3	<del>\$0.98</del> \$0.97
2029	<del>\$139.9</del> \$138.3	<del>\$0.96</del> \$0.95
2030	<del>\$147.2</del> \$145.5	<del>\$0.93</del> \$0.92
Avg. per Year	<del>\$136.4</del> \$134.9	<del>\$0.97</del> \$0.96

- Average of \$1.5 million less annually or \$6.0 million total over the 4-year period.
- Increase of \$210 in 2027 based on an average home AV of \$1.5 Million and then maintains a stable cost

# School Technology and Capital Projects Recommendation

Collection Year	Levy Amount (\$ in Millions)	Rate/\$1,000
2027	\$54.6	\$0.44
2028	\$59.4	\$0.44
2029	\$63.7	\$0.44
2030	\$69.2	\$0.44
Avg. per Year	\$61.7	\$0.44

- Average Collection Per Year \$61.7 million
- Increase of \$45 in 2027 based on an average home AV of \$1.5 Million and then maintains a stable cost
